

Bigordá-Suriñach would rather think of next rally.

Lluís Bigordà-Joaquim Suriñach (Peugeot 107) didn't get off to a good start in the Berguedà's Critèrium, an event of the Volant RACC Trofeo Galp Energía-MAVISA 2011. After a too conservative start in the morning sections, the puncture in the first go through Alpens shattered any options of recovery.

Bigordà-Suriñach decided to stay in the race anyway, despite not taking any risks; the special stages were in a very delicate state.

They ended up 10th in the classification, 8' behind Raluy-Morales, the winning team of the Volant 2011.

All together the Andorran driver would rather forget the beginning of this season; here is what he said about it: I've started the rally really slowly and couldn't find the proper driving rhythm at any time. They'd told me that the first special stage (Gauges) was very slippery and... Despite being far away from the best drivers, I still had much to go on and I though I could move up some places. But right on the first special stage of the afternoon (Alpens), we punctured and all the options went out the window. This kind of start is always a handicap, but Bigordà is optimistic: We are going to focus on the Rally of Girona; it will be difficult to match up the two or three best drivers, however I think we can get close and possibly step on the podium. We'll keep fighting.

The above mentioned Rally of Girona, second event in the Volant RACC 2011, will take place on the 11th June.
