## The 2nd meet of the TT Cup 2011 brings excitement to Ordino.

In the traditional meet of the Andorran TT Cup in Ordino, Albert Cabanes-Lluis Carrera, Josep Bringué-Ivan Bringué and Roger Troguet-Sergi Simó won their respective categories. The seven zone course, all of them artificially constructed, was completed within the 4 hour mark.

The event organised by the Automóvil Club d'Andorra took place in Prat de Querola, just like the two previous years, under perfect weather conditions: heat and sun throughout the entire day. Nonetheless, the greatest obstacle was the presence of mud in all the sections, which were crowded with fans waiting for the 11 competing teams.

In the XTREM category, Albert Cabanes-Lluis Carrera were once again the most proficient team and quickly left their opponents in their wake. Just like in Calvinyà, they shared the podium with Pujol and Guardiola, although this time these two teams switched places. This was the statement issued by the winner at the end of the race: *I really like racing in Ordino. I think most of the drivers as well as the audience look forward to this event. The mud and the customary technical zones make it very special. Thanks to this second victory, we are now the championship leaders, but it's not going to be easy to keep it up in all the races.*

Amongst the PREPARED vehicles, the differences were once again minimal. Josep Bringué triumphed, but he wasn't able to relax until the race was over. Here is what he said once he received his trophy: *It's been a really complicated day, but fun at the same time. We've won this second race but the championship is wide open in this category. The differences are insignificant and we obviously need to avoid all kinds of mistakes and to somehow be lucky with avoiding possible mechanical problems.*

This year was the first for the STANDARD vehicles in Ordino. Roger Troguet and Joel Martínez, the only two participants, staged a spectacular duel, which wasn't resolved until the very end of the race. This was the opinion of an elated Troguet: *It was a wonderful day because of the zones, the fight with Joel and most of all because I won*

Another really happy person was Juli Filloy, the designer of the Ordino route. He had talked about a surprise and he delivered; this was his comment about it: *The teams had to unscrew a back wheel and run around a track with it. Once back next to their car they had to screw it back on to finish the zone. It's not common to have to overcome this kind of obstacles, but in my opinion it's important to do something new so people don't get bored.*

The teams now have three weeks to work on their vehicles. The third race of the Andorran TT Cup will be on the 23rd September in Sant Julià de Lòria.
