



The TT Cup 2011 reaches its mid-point in La Massana.

Next Saturday (23rd), the TT Cup 2011 competitors will have a new opportunity to test their skills and keep increasing their points in their respective categories. The third event of the TT Cup 2011 this season, will take place at the earth dumping site in Beixalís (La Massana) with the Automovil Club d'Andorra's support.

It's worth pointing out that the setting has been specially chosen by the organization in order to be able to design a competitive course and still respect and preserve the environment. Keeping these priorities in mind, they have picked the fields adjacent to the earth dumping site in Beixalís, found on road CS-310 at km 8.

The course will have 7 zones in total and the novelty this time is that one of the zones will be timed.

The third event of the TT Cup 2011 is opened to the usual three classes of cars (Xtrem, Prepared and Standard). A maximum of 20 vehicles will be able to compete in La Massana's TT.

As previously stated, all the competitors will meet next Saturday (23rd) at 2 p.m., when the administrative and technical verifications will take place. Then the teams will be able to go through the zones for the reconnaissance and afterwards the organization will brief the drivers. From 4 p.m., the drivers and their vehicles will have a total of 4 hours to successfully overcome the obstacles, thus being granted a position amongst the best in the final classification.
