Amàlia Vinyes-Borja Rozada (Suzuki Swift) finished the 44 Rally of Ourense in 11th place of the Suzuki Cup classification. For the Andorran driver, this race has been haunted by two punctures she's had on the same special stage, San Pedro de Rocas, one in each go. She's lost 16' and all the options to improve her place during the rally.

It's been a really difficult start, especially the first go through San Pedro de Rocas, where apart from the puncture, I got out of the track and was forced me to slow down since I wasn't sure everything was ok in the car. After going to the service park and checking the car, the goal was to pick the pace and try to improve the times as the event went on. But we had the second puncture... well, luckily the afternoon was a bit better. These were the words of the Andorran driver who went through a very tough start in the Rally of Ourense. However, the positive aspect for her was the fact that she could increase the kilometres on the Suzuki Swift: And, moreover, get used to have someone next to me telling what lays ahead, since it's impossible to memorise it. It's my third rally this season, this one with Borja Rozada as my navigator, and it's obvious that I need to get use to it, so I can improve in the classification. Step by step, as I had to do in the circuits.

In the mix calendar Amàlia is doing this year, the next event will be in the Alcañiz circuit, on the 2nd and 3rd July. It will be the fourth race of the Spanish Endurance Cup, where Amàlia will be defending her leadership in the provisional classification of Class 1.
