Amàlia Vinyes-Aintzane Goñi overcome the challenge in Ferrol.

Amàlia Vinyes-Aintzane Goñi finished 11th in the Suzuki Swift Cup classification in the 42nd Ferrol Rally. The Andorran driver, who races a Suzuki Swift prepared by Baporo Motorsport, went through the rally without problems and with definite goals: increase the amount of kilometres on the Swift and fully immerse herself in the rally, which she has taken her first steps into this season, and in the settings, unknown to her from a driver's point of view.

There's no doubt that it's a really nice rally, but at the same time it's very difficult. The asphalt was very dirty and it was all too easy to make mistakes. Overall, I'm happy with the results, especially some of the partial times achieved. Every time I race, I feel more confident driving the Swift and getting the most out of my navigator's instructions. I think that, if we manage to be more consistent, we will be closer to reaching our goal, that is to say we will be among the fastest in the category. Obviously, the Andorran driver's confidence has improved a great deal, as was expected at the beginning of the season. Nevertheless, it's not going to be easy for Amàlia, having the same dates for both competitions is a problem: Yes, that's true... From the beginning of the season we decided we wanted to try and win the CER again, and that's what we are up to. Maybe I won't improve as fast as I would like to in the rallies because I won't be able to race much, this season I will only compete in 5 rallies out of 7. The other two coincide in dates with the CER races: the Rias Baixas because it was rescheduled but as far as the Principe goes we knew it was going to be this way. It's what happens when you race in such different competitions.

Thus, Amàlia Vinyes will miss the next race of the Suzuki Swift Cup, the Príncipe de Asturias, which will take place on the 9th and 10th September. The only reason is that she will be racing the next event of the Spanish Endurance Cup (CER) in the Circuit de Catalunya. Amàlia's goal in the Catalan track will be to keep her leadership of Class 1 and D4 category in the penultimate event of the competition.
