

## **Everything is ready for the XXI Borrufa Trophy**

The Organizing Committee of the Borrufa Trophy 2013 is finalizing the last details so tomorrow, at 10am, everything will be ready for the first races. The young skiers are eager to start one of the most prestigious trophies of the international ski season.

All along the week, the delegations of the competing countries have arrived in Andorra to go through the usual administrative processing before the beginning of the Torphy. All in all, 26 delegations are now ready to compete. Sadly, countries such as Algeria, the United States and Romania have withdrawn their participation at the last minute.

Mr Jaume Rifà, President of the Organizing Committee of the Borrufa Trophy, is very proud of the job done up until now and hopes to reach the excellent expectations raised for the competition. Here is what he said about it: We can't wait for the competition to start. I think that everything has gone according to plan up until now: most of the teams have already formalized their inscription and are already settled in their hotels. Some teams haven't been able to come, but these last minute changes are fairly common. Another element that can prove to be crucial is the weather, so far the forecast is not very positive: We will have to improvise a bit according to each day's situation. So far, we have established an initial plan, but it will depend on the condition of the slopes. Any changes will of course be made with the consent of the delegations.
