



## Jan Straka and Anna Oller winners of a very close category.

There have been some major changes between the two heats of the day, as well for the boys as for the girls. Thus, the most regular skiers of the Borrufa Trophy 2013, Jan Straka and Anna Oller, managed to get at the top of the initial slalom's overall ranking. It is worth mentioning that the five skiers that climb each of today's podiums were all from different nationalities, except for the Spanish team that had two of its members on the girls podium.

The best Andorran skier of the day was Jan Sasplugas, who finished third after an excellent second heat advancing four positions in the ranking.

The Czech skier, Jan Straka, talked about his performance before climbing the podium: *I'm very happy. The day has been very tough because of the harsh weather conditions (the wind and the snow), but despite it all I managed to keep a good pace and on the second heat I went for it and it worked.*

The only Andorran skier that got to the podium, Jan Sasplugas, was also very happy about his performance: *I was one of the last skiers to start the first heat, so I had to play it safe because the slope was not under the best conditions. On the second one, I had to improve a lot if I wanted to be amongst the best so I went down as fast as I could. The podium was the best reward.*

As for the girls' winner, Anna Oller, she established a very regular pace and according to her own words that was the key to win: *The slope was in a delicate estate, I couldn't make any mistakes and I didn't. I'm incredibly happy to have won.*

Sissi Hinterreitner, the best Andorran in both heats, gave a different approach to the Borrufa. Her words were as follows: *The results are obviously important, but I also appreciate having the opportunity to meet so many skiers from other countries. It is without any doubt a great experience.*

The participants of the U16 category hope for better weather, so they will be able to compete under more favourable conditions.
